About our online course

The Pharmacy Guild of Australia, in association with Gold Cross Products and Services, has developed an online course that prepares you for Medication Management Review (MMR) accreditation and lets you study when and where it suits you. The course uses case-based learning to give you a framework for approaching MMRs. It provides feedback, plus the chance to review and discuss MMR issues with colleagues and course facilitators.

The course provides:

- access to state-of-the-art computer-based training sessions in your own home or pharmacy, in your own time;
- improved knowledge and skills, through group interaction with peers, coordinated by an experienced, accredited pharmacist as the facilitator;
- a clinically structured course, involving various case studies, with particular emphasis on geriatric pharmacotherapeutics;
- access to course reference material online;
- assistance in improving skills in communication with consumers and other health professionals; and
- a user-friendly, internet-based process, involving varying degrees of interactivity.

Enrolments close two weeks prior to commencement of the course.

Each program will run for five to six weeks with an estimated 15-20 hours of participation over that period. The program is divided into structured case-based sessions. You have around a week to complete each session.

Upon successful completion of the preparation course (Stage 1) you will be eligible to complete the AACP accreditation requirement (Stage 2). The indicative times above do not include the time taken to attempt your first AACP case.

Total course cost \$1350 (inc. GST)

This cost does not include costs associated with AACP accreditation assessment.
